<u>Lake Forest Estates</u> – <u>Home Owners Association</u> – <u>Meeting Minutes</u> January 29, 2014

Open meeting – call to order – Kevin Bilkie Motion to second order – received

- 1. Recap from summer meeting provided
 - a. Elected 4 of 5 board members
 - b. Majority approved
- 2. Old Business:
 - a. Recap of Financials
 - b. Nine fourteen homes are delinquent on dues
 - c. Eight homes two years behind. Liens in process with attorney
 - d. Quorum Number
 - i. 60% of residences = 94 votes to establish quorum
 - ii. 48 votes to pass amendments

3. New Business:

- a. Amendment A Allow Fences with Restrictions
 - i. Discussion on amendments and by laws
 - ii. Note that nothing in amendments that restricts fence except by Nature Preserve
 - iii. Board wants to recommend fences with defined restrictions to maintain attractive integrity within Lake Forest
 - iv. Concern raised by resident, if vote no, would current homeowners with fences have to remove them. Response, no
 - v. No privacy fences allowed with the outlined restrictions
 - vi. Discussion of City of Macedonia restrictions
 - vii. Privacy fences are allowed along the neighborhood exterior perimeter.
 - viii. Oversight required to maintain integrity, as in other neighborhoods
 - ix. Reference raised to Article 7-1-C which allows fences.

- b. <u>Amendment B</u> <u>Dues</u>
 - i. Recommendation to increase dues to \$300. annually.
 - ii. Concerns expressed that doubling dues. Residents want to know where the money is going.
- c. <u>Amendment C</u> <u>Quorum</u>
 - i. Discussion on calculation of quorum
- d. Amendment D Recommendation to increase HOA Board
 - i. Increase board members to 5-7 members.
 - ii. Currently 4 board members
 - iii. Recommend adding additional board members next summer.
- 4. <u>Budget 2014</u>
 - a. Purpose of Assessment Kevin Bilkie clarified assessments are to improve/ repair/beautify the neighborhood
 - b. Proposed Lighted Fountain in Lake
 - i. Estimated \$5730. to \$7485 from General Landscaping
 - ii. Maintenance on fountains discussion. Recommend to remove during winter months and storage.
 - iii. Resident John M called three fountain companies:
 - 1. Concern with potential sand particles when John contacted Eagle Fountain
 - 2. Warranty issues and maintenance concerns
 - 3. Estimated energy costs could be \$150 \$300. per month? Need to understand how cost derived.
 - 4. Aqua Doc storage costs
 - c. Geese Issues:
 - i. Geese population increasing year over year
 - ii. Mess from Geese impacting residents who enjoy walking
 - iii. A couple residents enjoy the Geese
 - iv. Options for discouraging Geese Remediation discussed
 - v. Al Noe shared comments that remediation options does not guarantee that Geese will not come back each year.
 - vi. Consideration for lights around lakes at night to deter Geese.

- d. General Landscaping Section E mulch
 - i. John M question working with OSP regarding Nature Preserve.
- e. Bank Fees
 - i. Update LFE website to accept credit/debit card payments for dues and assessments
 - ii. Consideration raised for accepting Pay Pal payments
- f. Sign Decorations
 - i. Acknowledgment of holiday decorations
- g. Landscape Projects
 - i. Benches installed to allow residents to enjoy Nature Preserve.
 - ii. Drainage Pipe landscaping around Whispering Woods attractive
 - iii. Resident John M concern with spillway
- h. Project Fund future planning based on \$300./year
- i. Resident Voting Volunteer Residents to count ballots
